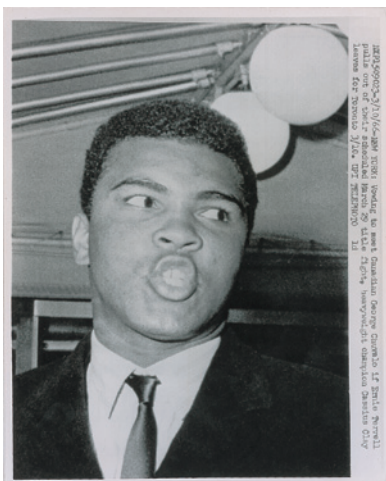




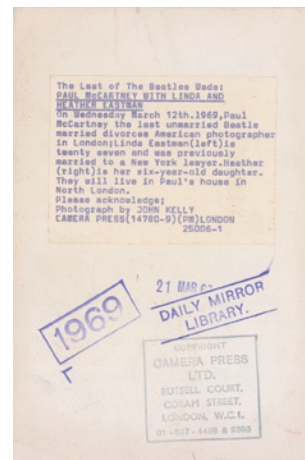
Alaska. Collection of approximately 49 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, showing Eskimos, railroads, scenes from the 1940s, and some photos celebrating Alaska's statehood. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Baseball. Collection of approximately 45 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Dizzy Dean with his wife, Daffy Dean pitching, Johnny Vander Meer on the field and with his teammates, and Hoot Evers in action on the field. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Muhammad Ali. Original 1966 news photo of Ali vowing to meet George Chuvalo if Ernie Terrell pulls out of their fight, 8 x 10, with an inherent caption to the right border. Mild news use and wear, including vintage news stamps to reverse.



Beatles: Paul and Linda McCartney. Original glossy 5.25 x 8 photo of Paul and Linda McCartney and their daughter Heather from 1969 shortly after they married. Lovely, sharp image. The back has the tag, stamp and 1969 stamp date of the Daily Mirror. The photo has edge wear, including edge chips and wrinkles.

Albert Anastasia. Collection of five photos relating to the mob boss, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, photos include images of Anastasia on trial as well as the aftermath of his murder. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Beatles: Paul and Linda McCartney. Original, 10 x 8, gelatin silver press photo of Paul and Linda in 1969, with Daily Mirror and 1969 stamped on back. Small tear to one side and edge wear.



Milton Berle. Collection of approximately 30 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Berle in various comic sketches, making funny faces, and various portraits. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Yogi Berra. Original 1955 news photo of Berra in his Yankees uniform, 8.5 x 12, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1955. Normal news use and wear, including a couple small tears to the upper right, production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.

British Suffragette. Original 1914 gelatin silver photograph of police helping a suffragette after fainting near Buckingham Palace, 6.5 x 8.5, bearing a 'Topical Press Agency' stamp and vintage notes about the image to the reverse. The image is crystal clear and full of character. General wear and clipped corners.



James Brown. Original 1984 news photo of Brown, 7.5 x 9, with numerous news clippings affixed to the reverse that feature the image. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and news stamps and tags.



Billie Burke. Collection of approximately 32 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, of Burke from throughout her career. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Roy Campanella. Collection of approximately 20 photos of Campanella, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, most post-accident. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Fidel Castro.

Original 1961 news photo of Castro at a podium giving a speech, 10 x 8, with a crowd of onlookers surrounding him. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Winston Churchill.

Collection of approximately 16 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, many showing Churchill at various public events. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Castro, Khrushchev, Brezhnev.

Original 1963 news photo of Fidel Castro atop the Lenin Mausoleum in Moscow with Nikita Khrushchev, Leonid Brezhnev, and



other Soviet officials, 10 x 7, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1963. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Winston Churchill. Collection of approximately 15 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, of several different Churchill statues and monuments. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Winston Churchill. Collection of approximately 40 photos relating to the death of Churchill consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, photos include images of public reaction to his death, as well as funeral and cemetery preparations. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Ty Cobb. Original 6.5 x 8.5 gelatin silver photo of Cobb autographing a bat for a young fan. Sharp and clear image with 1947 date stamp, International News Photos stamp, and affixed caption to reverse. Some light waves to the image, otherwise presents beautifully.



William F. 'Buffalo Bill' Cody. Original 1950 news photo of a gorgeous portrait of Cody, 7 x 9, bearing a caption and three news clippings affixed to the reverse that feature the image, stamp-dated 1965 and 1968. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps.



Dizzy Dean. Collection of approximately 18 photos spanning Dean's career, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, including several of Dean in uniform, with most photos from his retirement. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



William F. 'Buffalo Bill' Cody. Original vintage matte-finish 1923 news portrait of Cody, 6 x 10, featuring the famous Wild West showman in profile. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes.



Dizzy Dean . Six original 1930s photos of various sizes, depicting Dean off the field, including images of him playing cards and with his wife. Sharp images with period news stamps and tags on back. Photo show general wear including cropping marks, writing, and creases.



Crime and Mobsters. Collection of approximately 59 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including

images of Joe Gallo, mobster wives, murder scenes, a guillotine and an electric chair, the son of Pretty Boy Floyd, and protests against the death penalty. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Duesenberg. Collection of six photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of a Duesenberg Phaeton at auction, a Duesenberg J-101, and Sammy Davis Jr.'s Duesenberg 'replicar.' Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Johnny Evers. Collection of six photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Evers on the field with Joe Tinker, in his Boston Braves uniform, and as

manager of a minor league team. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Errol Flynn. Original 1936 news photo, 8 x 10, of Flynn with his wife, Lili Damita. Normal news use and wear, including production notes and vintage news stamps and tags to reverse.

Douglas Fairbanks, Sr. and Mary Pickford. Original 1929 news photo of America's definitive screen couple, 6 x 8, bearing an affixed caption and 'International Newsreel' stamp to the reverse. Sharp image with no creases or tears.



Greta Garbo. Original 1926 news photo, 6 x 9.25, of Garbo in a flowing skirt. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Federico Fellini. Two original 4.75 x 6.5 gelatin silver news photos of Fellini, dated 1960 and 1970, each bearing an affixed caption and 'Camera Press' stamp to the reverse. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Greta Garbo. Original 1960 news photo of Garbo in an elegant dress, 7 x 9.25, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1960. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Ava Gardner. Original glossy 8 x 10 publicity photo of Gardner, stamp-dated 1961. Stamps, tags and writing to reverse, a small tear to top, and ink enhancements to image.



Harlem. Collection of approximately 17 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of street scenes, riots, buildings, and families. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Hoot Gibson. Collection of approximately 20 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, most from Gibson's films, with a few from his personal life including a photo with Johnny Weissmuller, and one of Gibson being carried on a stretcher after an air crash in a race against Ken Maynard. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Lou Gehrig. Original 1938 news photo of Gehrig's appearance in the movie Rawhide, 7 x 9, bearing an affixed caption and 'World Wide Photos' stamp to the reverse. Clean and sharp image, with various light wear including wrinkles and edge wear.

Charles Gehringer. Collection of 14 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Gehringer at bat, in the field, and on the bases, wearing his Navy uniform, and with teammates, including Hank Greenberg. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Mata Hari. Collection of four photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of the notorious spy in an exotic dress. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Patty Hearst. Original 1976 news photo of Hearst in manacles, 7.5 x 10.5, with an inherent caption to the right border. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and news stamps to reverse.



Horrors of War . Collection of seven original news service photos 8 x 10 and smaller: German man on steps of Weiden church praying for end of war (1945 International News), Sullen Nazi S. S. Officer captured (1945 Keystone), Russian couple identify dead soldier son killed by Germans (1942 Ministry of Information), Gas Masked Moor soldiers fight Franco (1937 International News), Bombed out Belgian Church (undated International News, second generation image), Hiroshima atomic bomb wreckage (1945 International News), Bosnian Muslim refugee mother and baby (1992 Reuter). Photos have proper stamps and some have tags. Some have notes on back, one has crop marks on front.



Hippies. Collection of approximately 20 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, showing young people in the late 1960s enjoying life and protesting. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Carl Hubbell. Quality assortment of 27 photos of baseball great Carl Hubbell including his stamp dated rookie year portrait. Most are circa 1930s originals from his playing days, including some with his family and wife. Several others are picturing Hubbell when older. Most are originals with a few vintage wirephotos. A good number of high quality baseball shots from the 1920s and

1930s including pitching poses and in uniform shots. Photos show general wear and usage, with editorial marks on front and back and period news stamps. Nice collection.

Ben Hogan. Original 1942 news photo, 8 x 11.75, of Hogan ready to drive the ball out of the rough. Light normal news use and wear, including production notes and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Miller Huggins. Original vintage news photo of Huggins observing the Giants batting practice at the Polo Grounds before his Yankees played them in the World Series, 6.5 x 8.5, bearing an affixed caption and 'International Newsreel' stamp to the reverse. Mild news use and wear and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Miller Huggins. Collection of seven photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, all relating to the passing of Huggins including a shot of his funeral and the unveiling of his monument in Yankee Stadium. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



John F. Kennedy. Original vintage news photo, 10 x 8, of Kennedy addressing a group of gentlemen. Mild normal news use and wear.



Don Hutson. Original 1941 news photo of Green Bay Packers wide receiver Don Hutson scoring a touchdown to set the all-time single season scoring record, 8 x 11.75, with an inherent caption to the lower border. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, vintage news stamps and tags, and a couple small tears to the top.



Vladimir Lenin. Original 1955 news photo of Lenin, 4.75 x 6.5, bearing an affixed caption and 'Daily Mirror' stamp to the reverse. Normal news use and wear, including light toning and silvering, production notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Al Jolson. Original vintage news photo of Jolson in the Broadway musical Sinbad, 7 x 12.25, bearing a White Studio of New York stamp to the reverse. Light chips and tears to edges, normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Harold Lloyd. Collection of approximately 20 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, from Lloyd's professional and personal life, including several film publicity images. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Huey Long. Collection of approximately 50 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, primarily including portraits and images of public appearances. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Myrna Loy. Original glossy 10 x 8 Clarence Sinclair Bull MGM publicity photo of Loy and Melvyn Douglas for the upcoming film Third Finger. Reverse bears Bull's MGM stamp and 1940 date stamp on back. Light general wear.

Lucky Luciano. Collection of 10 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, from later portions of Luciano's career, and incarceration, as well as a photo announcing his death. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Connie Mack. Collection of approximately 15 photos of Mack, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, showing Mack from his managerial days and retirement, as well as a couple of photos of a Mack statue. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

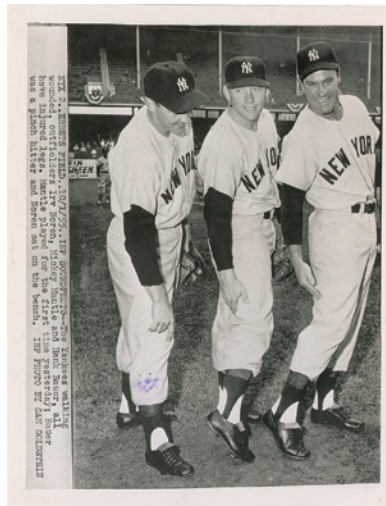


Connie Mack. Collection of 19 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Mack as the manager of the Philadelphia Athletics, demonstrating his batting stance, and meeting other sports notables like Bobby Jones, Gene Tunney, and Clark Griffith. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Jayne Mansfield. Three semi-glossy wire photos, various sizes, two of the accident scene which took Mansfield's life and one of her funeral, all stamped on the reverse June-July 1967. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Mickey Mantle. Original 1955 news photo of Mantle with fellow Yankees outfielders Irv Noren and Hank Bauer, 7 x 9, with an inherent caption to the left border and an 'International News Photo' stamp to reverse. Mild normal news use and wear, including production notes and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Roger Maris. Original 1961 news photo of Maris hitting a go-ahead home run in the 9th against the Reds in Game 3 of the World Series, 12 x 8.5, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1961. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Mickey Mantle and Yogi Berra. Original 1957 news photo of Mantle with fellow Yankees Yogi Berra and Hank Bauer, 10 x 8, with an inherent caption to the lower border and a news clipping

affixed to the reverse that features the image. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Roger Maris. Original 1962 news photo of Maris flipping his bat after a strikeout in the World Series opener against the Giants, 8 x 11, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1962. Normal news use and wear, production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.

Heinie Manush. Collection of nine photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Manush at bat and on the bases, jogging on the beach, and at a golf tournament.



Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Roger Maris. Original 1962 news photo of Maris doubling to drive in the first two runs of the World Series at Candlestick Park, 12 x 7.5, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1962. Normal news use and wear, production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Joe McCarthy. Collection of approximately 35 photos from McCarthy's managerial career and retirement, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, showing McCarthy in both Yankee and Red Sox uniforms, as well as posing with several Hall of Famers. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



J. Pierpont Morgan. Original 1929 news photo of Morgan arriving in New York upon the Mauretania, 6 x 8, bearing an affixed caption and Associated Press stamp to the reverse. Light normal news use and wear, including production notes and vintage news stamps to reverse.

New York City.

Collection of approximately 75 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including photos of hospitals and asylums, the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts, Governors Island, highways, and the foreign-trade zone on Staten Island. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



New York City Fire Department.

Collection of approximately 24 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including photos of the New York City Fire Department putting out fires, doing training exercises, and testing their fireboat. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



New York City Hotels. Collection of approximately 67 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, depicting exteriors and interiors of hotels from around New York City, including the Hotel Astor, Savoy Plaza Hotel, Ritz-Carlton, New Yorker, Americana, and many of the Waldorf-Astoria. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Richard Nixon.

Collection of approximately 23 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, of impeachment proceedings against Nixon, as well as a couple photos of impeachment protests. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Richard Nixon.

Collection of approximately 19 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, primarily including images of President Nixon's trip to China in 1972. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Posters. Collection of approximately 49 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of posters from around the world, encompassing topics ranging from concerts to political campaigns.

Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Richard Nixon. Collection of approximately 34 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of Nixon's inauguration and related festivities, as well as a counter-inaugural protest. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Will Rogers. Original 1935 news photo of Rogers at the time he had been elevated to stardom by his Ziegfeld performances, 6.5 x 8.5, bearing an affixed caption and 'International Newsreel' stamp to the reverse. Light rippling to edges and vintage news stamps and tags to reverse.



Panama-Pacific Exhibition. Collection of approximately 93 photos from the 1915 Panama-Pacific International Exposition, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, showing the various pavilions and buildings as well as several photos of attending dignitaries. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Will Rogers. Two photos: one original 1930 news photo of Rogers in a fedora, 7.75 x 9.75, with a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image; and one original vintage news photo of a young Rogers, 8 x 10, with a Clarence S. Bull stamp to the reverse. Normal news use and wear to both photos, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags, and heavy paper loss to the Bull photo.



Rolling Stones: Brian Jones. Original 1967 news photo of Jones and his two girlfriends, Suki Potier and Nicky Brownne, 10 x 7.25, bearing an inherent caption to the lower border. Sharp image with cropping marks and ink enhancement. Various stamps and editorial notes to reverse. General wear including edge wear, a few creases, and wrinkles.

Julius and Ethel Rosenberg. Collection of 27 vintage wire-photos, press photos and newsphotos related to the Rosenberg's trial and execution. Some show the couple, other show protests and group scenes. Expected news wear and usage, including crop marks, notes and stamps.



Bugsy Siegel. Five glossy photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, one of Siegel announcing his death, two of his home, and two others related to his death. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Casey Stengel. Original 1949 news photo of Stengel leaning on a bat, 7.75 x 12, bearing an 'International News Photo' stamp to the reverse. Normal news use and wear, production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Babe Ruth and Honus Wagner. Original glossy 8.5 x 6.5 photo of the smiling baseball legends chatting at a formal event. Original paper caption tag and press stamp on back, along with 1938 date stamps.



Casey Stengel. Collection of approximately 50 photos, consisting primarily of glossy press photos, various sizes, from Stengel's term as Mets manager as well as his retirement, both individual and group photos. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Igor Stravinsky. Original 1957 news photo of Stravinsky recording his own 'Persephone' for Columbia Records, 9.25 x 7.5, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1957. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Norm Van Brocklin . Collection of 28 photos, various sizes, used for publication from 1948–1979 with most from the 1960s. Group includes a 1954 action photo by Vic Stein, an action photo from 1947 when Van Brocklin was playing for Oregon, and a 1955 action photo of Van Brocklin while with the Los Angeles Rams. Group also includes original press photos, wirephotos and laserphotos, ranging in quality. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes. Photos also have the vintage news stamps and tags.



Harry S. Truman. Collection of four photos, consisting of glossy press photos, various sizes, including images related to an assassination attempt on November 1, 1950. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.



Booker T. Washington. Original 1964 news photo of Washington in a suit and bow tie, 7.75 x 10, bearing a news clipping affixed to the reverse that features the image, stamp-dated 1964. Normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps to reverse.



Gene Tunney. Collection of approximately 38 photos, consisting of printed wire photos and glossy press photos, various sizes, including images of him in military uniform and Native American garb as an honorary chief, various portraits, and meeting politicians and other boxers. Photos have normal news use and wear, including production marks and notes, and vintage news stamps and tags.

Florenz Ziegfeld. Original 1932 news photo of Ziegfeld used to promote his 'Ziegfeld Follies of the Air' radio program, 8 x 10, bearing a caption affixed to the reverse describing the show. Normal news use and wear, including vintage news stamps and tags to reverse.
